Student soil scientists can apply for \$750 to support their registration at the 19<sup>th</sup> World Congress of Soil Science in Brisbane from August 1-6, 2010. The following conditions will apply:

1. The applicant must be a student member of the South Australian Branch of the Australian Society of Soil Science with a minimum of 12 months membership to ASSSI.
2. The applicant must have an abstract accepted for a poster or oral presentation at the conference and attach a copy of their abstract to this application, with their supervisor's approval (see below).
3. A committee of the SA Branch will evaluate the application and offer awards of \$750 per person.
4. Successful applications will be asked to present their papers to a special SA Branch meeting prior to the World Congress, probably during mid-July. This should be seen as a practice run and opportunity to receive beneficial feedback.
5. On return from the conference the successful applicants must write a short report (about 500 words and including photograph/s) to be submitted to the SA Branch and for publication in Profile. The deadline for submission of this short report is 1<sup>st</sup> November 2010.
